Archery

August 2-6 • 9am - 12pm • 4-8th • \$150

Join this camp as a beginner or with some experience. Participants learn how to safely shoot a bow and arrow, strengthen their aim with lots of target practice, and experiment with different types of bows.

Art in Nature

August 2-6 • 9am - 12pm • K5-3rd • \$165

Art is everywhere and is fun to create! This camp uses nature to inspire art projects. Go on a treasure hunt to find rocks to paint, sticks to create sculptures, and other nature inspired art supplies. Create amazing pieces using the raw materials of nature each day.

Book Look

August 2-6 • 9am - 12pm • K4-K5 • \$165

Reading is a lifelong skill! Be prepared with pre-reading skills such as letter-sound recognition and letter identification and foster a love of reading with lots of exciting activities related to books. Participants will enjoy fun games and activities infused with learning to prepare them for reading.

Cheerleading

August 2-6 • 9am - 12pm • K5-5th • \$150

Go team! Come learn the basics of cheerleading in a super fun camp! Cheerleaders learn cheers with the movements and chants, along with how to project their voices to lead a crowd. They create cute cheer accessories like hair bows, megaphones, and pom-poms. On Friday there is a pep rally for family.

Code Your Own Arcade from Scratch

August 2-6 • 9am - 12pm • 3-6th • \$180

Powered by Code Ninjas®, campers explore different programming concepts as they create various games- including Block Stacker, Catch Cats, Dodgeball and Red Light, Green Light- using a block-based programming language called Scratch. Each game focuses on a different type of block (or programming concept) and provides campers with extra tools to use in their own games. Concepts include variables, loops, functions, animation, clones, video detection, audio detection and more!

Get Ready for 1st Grade

August 2-6 • 9am - 12pm • 1st • \$165

Preparing for 1st grade builds confidence for a great school year! This camp reviews key skills needed for success in grade 1. Led by an experienced K5 teacher, this camp focuses on the reading and math skills many children struggle with when starting 1st grade, such as word attack skills, sight words, and number fluency.

Get Ready for 3rd Grade

August 2-6 • 9am - 12pm • 3rd • \$165

This camp is the perfect place for 3rd graders to review key skills in reading, writing, and math for school year success! Reading review includes fluency practice and comprehension practice with literary devices, context clues, and plot summaries. The writing review offers strategies for expressing ideas with correct grammar. Math review focuses on key skills such as multi-digit addition and subtraction, fact fluency, strategies for problem solving, and place value.

Get Ready for 5th Grade

August 2-6 • 9am - 12pm • 5th • \$165

This camp reviews key reading, math, and writing skills for success in 5th grade. Comprehension is key for reading success and this camp practices comprehension strategies so students are reading for content. An important part of prep this week is writing. This includes the writing process and developing ideas into written communication through correct grammatical functions and precise word choice. Math skills are also reviewed to include fractions, ratios, percentages, multiplication and division fluency, place value, and problem solving strategies.

Get Ready for Algebra I

August 2-6 • 9am - 12pm • 7-8th • \$165

Students must be entering Algebra I in the fall to join as camp reviews the building block skills needed for success. Review includes practice with math skills such as algebraic reasoning, variables, order of operations, distribution, ratios and fractions. Fluency games to refresh multiplication/division facts and to review math reasoning are played along with traditional math practice problems.

Sewing Advanced

August 2-6 • 9am - 12pm • 4-7th • \$185

This camp is designed for those with some sewing machine experience. Sewers will learn how to use a pattern to create a cross body bag with a zipper and a simple skirt. Campers should bring 1 yard of quilting fabric and 1 yard of 3/8" wide elastic for the skirt. All other materials are provided but participants may bring their own sewing machine if desired.

Super Sleuth

Calling all aspiring detectives to Challenge Island's® Super Sleuth Camp. Our eagle-eyed tribes will work together on Top Secret challenges such as CSI, Scooby Doo, Sherlock Holmes, and Nancy Drew! So, grab your detective gear and prepare to go undercover this summer!
