

General Information

Eligibility: Camps are open to any student who is rising K4 to 8th grade during the 2022-23 school year. All K4 campers must be 4 years old by June 1, 2021 and must be fully potty trained.

Camp format: There are full day and half day camps. Full day camps are from 9am to 4pm and half day camps are either AM from 9am to 12pm or PM from 1-4pm. Campers can join both an AM & PM in one week to create a full day. All campers who stay full day eat lunch from 12-1pm.

Early Care & Late Stay: Early care and late stay can be added to any week during the registration process. Early care is available from 7:30-9am for \$30. Late stay is available from 4-5:30pm for \$30. Either session can be added at a daily rate of \$6/day as needed by contacting a director.

Registration: Please register for camps online at www.afterschoolplus.com. **Registration begins March 1.** If you need assistance, you may contact us at 864-881-4666. We love to talk camp and are happy to help you select the best camps to create an amazing summer for your family!

Payments and Refunds: Payment must be made at the time of registration to reserve your spot in a camp. You may select to pay your camps in full or make a deposit. **Payment in full is required by June 1.** Any balances remaining after June 1 will be automatically charged to your card on file. Payments can be made at any time between registration and June 1 by logging into your account.

Behavior & Discipline: Our discipline focuses on techniques that include positive reinforcement, redirection, conflict resolution and rewards. A child with a consistent behavioral problem is sent to the Director and parents are notified. If negative behavior persists a child may be removed from our program and no refund is given.

Location: All camps meet at After School Plus located at 255 Service Bay Road, Mauldin, SC 29662. We also have fields and an outdoor classroom at our former location 510 South Main Street, about 1 mile away. Some outdoor camps will utilize our secondary location. Transportation to our outdoor space is provided by ASP bus.

What to bring: Please wear clothing and shoes appropriate for the camp content. Bring a water bottle. Campers who stay all day need to bring a lunch from home. Please leave toys, games and electronics not needed for camp at home. If campers bring a phone it needs to stay in their bag and may only be used at the discretion of the teacher.

Lunch & Snack: Snack is included in all camps. Full day campers receive both AM & PM snack. In addition there are vending snacks, drinks, and ice creams available for \$1 each, cash only. Campers must bring a lunch from home each day, except on Fridays there is optional lunch for purchase. "Fun Foodie Friday" includes two slices of pizza with fruit and yogurt for \$5. Microwaves are available to campers each day.

Carline: There are 4 carlines each day. AM/Full day drop off is from 8:45-9am. AM pick-up is from 12-12:15pm. PM drop-off is from 12:45-1pm and PM/Full day pick-up is from 4-4:15pm. There is no carline for early care or late stay. Please park and come into our lobby to drop-off/pick up for those sessions.

Field trip transportation: All field trip transportation is by ASP bus. We have mini-buses and full sized buses and licensed CDL drivers when needed.
