Adventures in Game Design Coding

Powered by Code Ninjas®, ninjas (friends) will explore different programming concepts as they create various games using a block-based programming language called Scratch—a kid-friendly, visual programming environment developed by MIT. Our team will introduce basic game design and programming concepts like loops, functions, and more to create their own games.
